Persian Miniature Course:

From preparation to practice

The course is designed to take the participants on a pleasant journey to the materials, colors, paper preparation and styles of Persian miniatures.

During the course, students will be guided to the various stages of making Persian miniature by experiencing the process. Students will learn how to:

- Prepare the paper for painting;
- Draw the nature in Persian miniature;
- Transfer our painting into prepared paper;
- Choose color combinations for nature;
- Apply layers of color;
- Outline, elaborate and add delicate details.

No background in arts is necessary; beginners are welcome to start and move forward step by step whereas students who already have a background knowledge and/or experience will be taught according to their level.

The course will run every Monday, 6:30-8:30pm at SOAS (room 563) from 7 October to 9 December 2019.
